### Banking Machines

For your convenience ATM machines are located on main street, in the tradeshow building, Molson Saloon and the Chevy concert bowl.

### Garbage Collection

Please assist us in keeping our grounds clean. Upon arrival, all campers will receive a garbage bag. When full, place it by the roadway, a clean up crew will remove it for you and replace your bag with a new one. This service is offered daily.

### Lost & Found / Message Board

Look for the message boards by the will call booth and on the westend of main street. Lost and Found is located at the on-site Police Station. (See #26 on Site Map)

### Concessions

Concessions will be open Thursday to Sunday 8:00 am - 3:00 am daily. A wide variety of food and beverages available. Cash only is accepted. Non-approved vendors are prohibited on the grounds or in the campsite area.

### Medical Assistance

Medical Assistance is located north of the Police Station as well as in the Chevy Concert Bowl during show time. Assistance is available 24 hrs / day commencing Thursday.

### Handicap Transport Services

The Handicap Transportation Booth is located on Main Street commencing Thursday noon - 11:00 pm, Fri, Sat & Sun 7:30 am - 11:00 pm. Additional pick up/drop off points are located in front of the CRE building, near the VIP entrance in the Chevy Concert Bowl and Handicap Camping area.

### Souvenirs

Visit our three locations on site - Big Valley Boutique located on main street and the Artist Souvenir Booths located beside the stage in both the Chevy concert bowl and the Molson Saloon.

### Souvenir Program Sales

Programs can be purchased upon arrival at the Processing Lanes or you can look for our sales staff near the Main Street Souvenir Booth, the Information Booth or the entrance into the Chevy Concert Bowl.

### Information Booth

Located on Main Street, open daily commencing Wednesday. Information also available at the ticket pick up booth. Assistance is available in locating lost children.

### Chevy Autograph Tent

Located in the Chevy Concert Bowl beside the stage, announcements will be made from the main stage as to which artists will be signing autographs.

### Panhandle Productions Ltd.

Supplies water tanks and porta potties in the campgrounds for your convenience. We ask that you report to Security or Police any person(s) tampering with these provided amenities.

### City of Camrose Shuttle:

## Campground Information

Gates open at 8:00 am Wednesday, July 29, 2009 and close at midnight daily. All vehicles not processed by midnight will be required to park in the Processing Lanes until the gates reopen the following morning.

For 2009 **ALL CAMPING IS ASSIGNED**. The Order Desk Computer will assign the next available stall when each order is processed. A Camping Fee will be charged.

The Big Valley Jamboree grounds (including campgrounds) is a “closed site”. Therefore, appropriate wristbands must be worn at all times beyond the check point areas.

There are a maximum of 6 people allowed per site, a camping unit, and a second vehicle. A camping unit will be defined as: 1) a truck & trailer, 2) a motorhome, 3) a car with a maximum of 3 tents. Campsites are based on double occupancy, thus for every 2 (2) 3-day passes purchased, you may purchase one campsite.

The fee charged for camping is for the campsite for the entire weekend, and not per person staying in the site. Maximum of 6 persons allowed per site.

Camping stickers must be placed on the motor vehicle belonging to the camping unit.

Lost or stolen camping/ vehicle stickers will not be replaced.

Only one second vehicle sticker will be issued per paid stall.

*All Vehicles will be subject to search upon entering the Grounds.*

*Camping areas must be kept clean and maintained. Each camp site note cleaned up properly at the end of the event will be charged a \$250.00 clean up fee to the site holders credit card. Panhandle Productions has the right to remove any persons not adhering to this.*

*All vehicles/camping units need to be off the site by 10 AM Monday, to accommodate clean up crew.*

*All Campground Occupants must wear a 3-Day Wristband.*

*Single Day Attendees will not be permitted in any Camping Areas, this includes Thursday Night Kick Off Tickets.*

VIP, Family & Reserved camping has a noise curfew of 12:00 am, and Chevy Camping has a noise curfew of 2:00 am. These curfews are strictly enforced. Please be mindful of your neighbours.

Intense loud stereo equipment is prohibited at all times. A reasonable noise level as to not disturb your neighbours is acceptable.

Due to pedestrian traffic in the campground we ask that all vehicles in the campground be operated in an orderly manner and that vehicle traffic be kept to a minimum. After dark traffic will be limited to emergency vehicles only.

Alcoholic beverages are allowed to be consumed in campsite areas only. Alcohol consumption is prohibited on any roadways.

Please keep anything of value locked up at your Campsite during the event.

**Any misuse or violation with a motor vehicle is prohibited. Any persons caught mud bogging will be evicted. TAMPERING OF CAMPSITE FLAGS WILL RESULT IN EVICTION.**

**No trampolines. No Household Furniture. No Structures of any Kind. Fireworks are prohibited.**

BBQ's and camp stoves are welcome but **open fires are NOT permitted.**

**All-terrain vehicles, golf carts, horses, mopeds, dirt bikes, scooters and minibikes are prohibited.**

**Stalls are assigned. Roping off of additional stalls is prohibited.**

**The RV Water and Sewer numbers will be posted on site.**

**Camping units and vehicles must not park in fire lanes. Fire lanes must remain clear at all times. Camping units must not form circles or close in camping areas due to fire regulations. If fire lanes are found to be blocked, Panhandle Productions Ltd. Has the right to have the vehicles towed at the owners expense.**

## Concert Bowl

Take your lawn chairs along with you to the Chevy Concert Bowl for the best view of the stars (unless you have purchased VIP or Reserved Seating). Please remember to take your chairs with you at the end of the day. You may return into the concert bowl and place your chairs for the next day once the nightly clean up has been completed. (A line up is formed and a maximum of 2 chairs / person can be carried in and set up. Those persons with more than 2 chairs / person will be required to form a separate line and will be directed once the first line is finished).

An area at the front of General Admission is available for the Physically Challenged and a maximum of two guests are allowed to accompany that person. Chairs must also be removed at the end of the day and may be returned once clean up has been completed. Please join the same line as regular seating.

*For the safety and comfort of all patrons the following items will not be allowed through the pat down gates: glass bottles, unsealed beverage containers of any kind (including bottled water), video or audio recording devices, weapons, frisbees, fireworks, alcohol, umbrellas, pets or high-back lawn chairs.*

**Lost or stolen wristbands will not be replaced.**

*All patrons entering are subject to search by Panhandle Productions Staff.*

Still shot cameras are welcome. There is an area for you to line up and take photos at the side of the stage.

Panhandle Productions Ltd. is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged goods. All articles are left at the risk of the owner.

Panhandle Productions Ltd. has the right and will execute that right to remove any person(s) in regards to unruly or crude behaviour set out by the enclosed guidelines.

Entrance to the concert area by appropriate wristband only.

### Beer Garden/Licenced Area Information

- Absolutely no minors allowed in any licensed area.

- All persons appearing 25 yrs. and younger will be required to provide photo ID.

- Alcohol is not permitted to be taken out of the Beer Gardens nor any other liquids in any other open containers.

- Standing or jumping on picnic tables is prohibited.

- Entrance by appropriate wristband only.

- All patrons are subject to search.

- The following items are Not Allowed into the Beer Gardens:

- Chairs (of any kind), glass bottles, video or audio recording devices, fireworks, alcohol, umbrellas, pets.

- Unsealed beverage containers of any kind (including bottled water)

**Can you be evicted from your campsite?**

Most definitely. Excessive noise, not wearing a three-day wristband, messy campsite, vandalism, and consuming alcohol outside of your campsite (to mention a few) are all grounds for eviction. Make sure that you pay attention to the rules posted on site. Evictions will result in the removal of your wristband and a police escort off of the site. Camping areas must also be kept clean and maintained. Each camp site not cleaned up properly at the end of the event will result in a \$250 clean up fee charged to the site holder's credit card.

**What are we allowed / not allowed to bring into the campgrounds?**

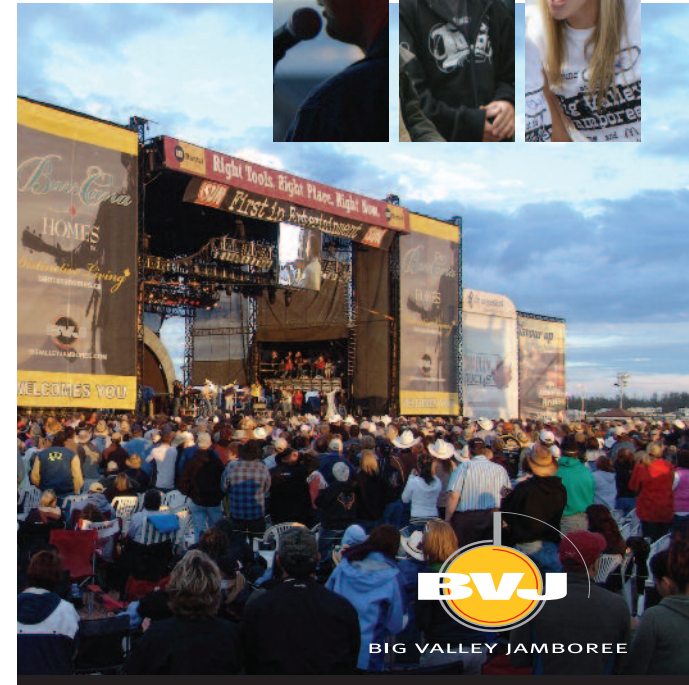
**Are pets allowed?**

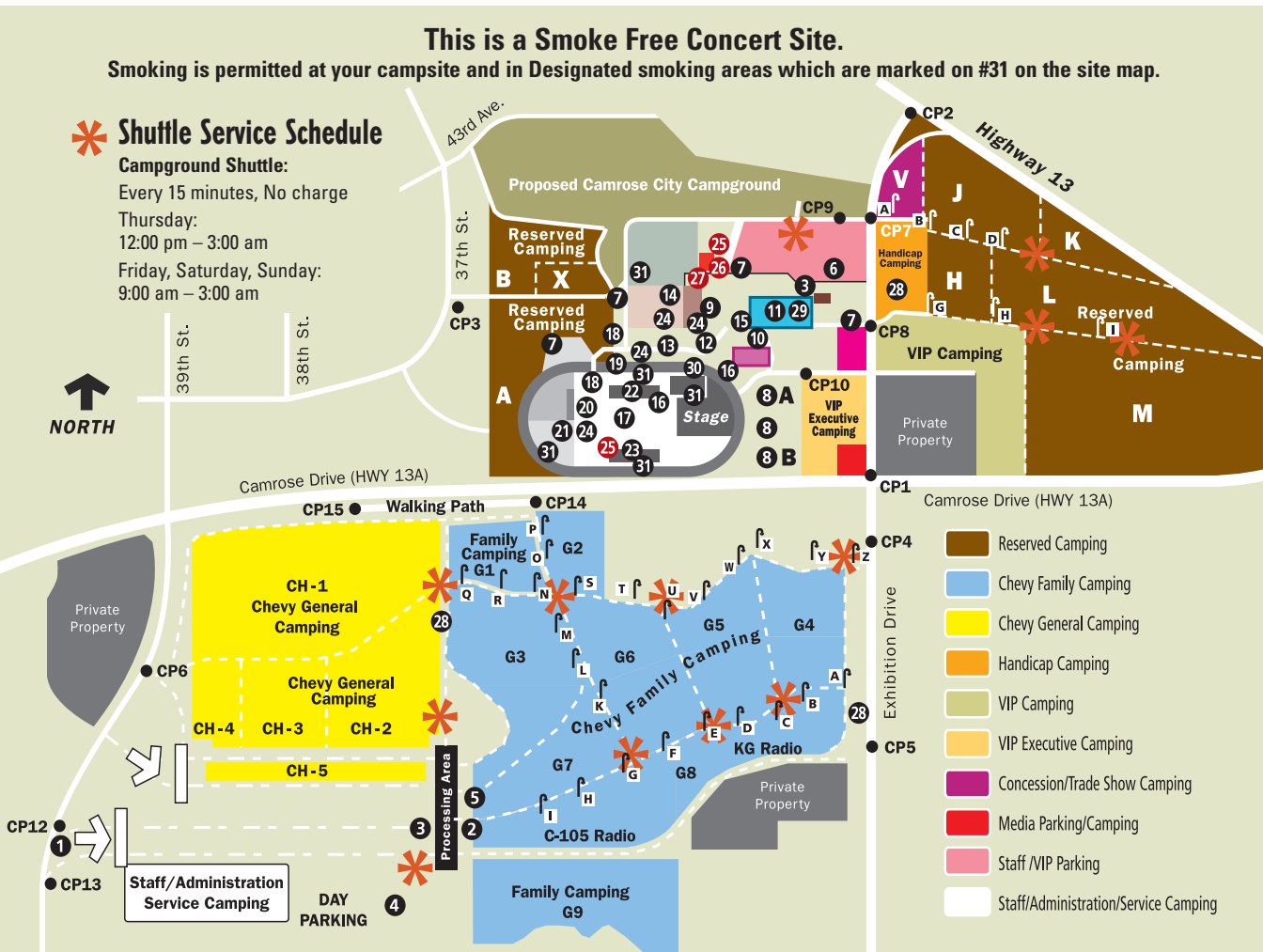
